## English

## *Through the Ages*

This is an exciting history topic that takes us back to when the first men and women were in Britain. We will find out how they survived, what incredible inventions they created to be able to live and what life would have been like during the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age.

When we reach the Iron Age, we will be learning about forces and magnets finding out if all metals attract. We will be experimenting with magnets and also finding out how to use different metals for different uses.

As well as experimenting with numbers and recapping the four operations we will be using measurements to find the area and perimeters of shapes and measure an area that will be appropriate to set up our own village in the Stone Age!
