Dear Parents and Carers,

Visit to Stratford Butterfly Farm – Monday 18th June 2018

Next half term we are undertaking many learning activities related to mini-beasts all linking with, among other things, the Understanding the World strand of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.

We have arranged an educational visit for Foundation Stage children to **Stratford Butterfly Farm**, which will provide practical, relevant and worthwhile experiences and also be lots of fun! The children will be taken on a tour around the butterfly farm and will have the opportunity to handle various creatures.

Our visit to the Butterfly Farm will take place on **Monday 18th June**, leaving school at 9.10 am and returning by 1.30pm. Please note Nursery children should be collected at this time on this day.

Nursery children will need a packed lunch in a named carrier bag on the day, with one drink to have with lunch (no fizzy drinks, cans or glass bottles please) and one small named disposable bottle of water they can have when needed. Reception children will be provided with a lunch from the school cook through the school meals program (this is not available to Nursery children yet as they are not registered as full time at school). Please indicate below and specify the filling required in your child's sandwich. Packed lunches are supplied with a drink but an extra named small disposable bottle of water should be sent in from home.

Please take account of the weather on the day – sunhat & sunscreen (already applied) if appropriate as we may get to play in the park nearby. Equally a hood would help if the day is wet. The children should wear school uniform for the visit.

The cost of the trip will be **£13.50** per child. This pays for their entrance fee and the coach. School has kindly offered to pay for any parent helper entrance fee costs in order to keep the cost of this trip to a minimum. There is no obligation to contribute and no pupil will be prevented from going on the trip because of non-payment. However, in the event of insufficient contributions (i.e less than 80%) it will be necessary for the trip to be cancelled; please speak to Mrs Anderton if you have any difficulties making payment. If your child is registered as being eligible for free school meals their contribution is covered by the Pupil Premium grant.
