Rainbow Awards

Presented to years FS1 – Year 2

Red (10)– Orange (15) – Yellow (15) – Green (20) – Blue (20) – Indigo (25) – Violet (25) – Gold (50)

Stickers are awarded at staff discretion for excellent work over and above what may be expected and for exceptional effort to achieve what is being asked of them. They can also be awarded for being helpful and for helping others within the class.

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Smiley Awards

Presented to years 3-6.

Bronze – Silver – Gold – Platinum – Emerald – Ruby – Sapphire – Diamond. The number of stamps needed for each level increases.

The onus is on the child to go through their books, locate the teacher's award (S in a circle), put a stamp on their smiley sheet and then cross the symbol out in their books.

Caught Being Good

Presented to FS2 – Year 6.

All adults in school, teachers, assistants, office staff and midday supervisors can award a raffle ticket to a child if they 'catch them being good'.

The child/adult writes their name and class on the back of the ticket and puts it in the box in the hall.

One ticket will be drawn out of the box each Friday and the child can choose a prize.

Star of the Week

This award is given at the teacher's discretion to the child who has made exceptional progress or has achieved something outstanding during the course of the week. This can be for exceptional work or effort in a particular subject or activity.
