



‘DROP OFF’ SCHEME

Starting 26th February

Do you drive your children to school?

If so, please read this!

Following feedback from parents and local residents, we successfully canvassed the local highways team to remove the restrictions on the layby outside school in order to create a safe ‘Drop Off Zone’ for you and your children. The aims of this are:

- To help reduce congestion around school due to less cars being parked on the road
- Increase safety for our pupils
- Be more convenient for parents who need to leave school quickly or who have under school aged children in the car too

We are the first school in Solihull to trial this **BUT** it will only work if drivers follow a few rules...

- **NO PARKING** in the layby
- The Drop Off Zone is only for parents who are happy for their children to exit the car on their own under the supervision of school staff. Parents must stay in the car and be ready to move away from school
- Children should only exit the vehicle when your car is at the front of the queue next to the staff member and **they should get out kerbside only**
- The Drop Off Zone can **only be used from the direction of the roundabout** by the shops (see map overleaf). Do not enter it from the direction of Fillongley – either drive down to the roundabout and come back up, or turn left down Leys Lane and then back towards to school
- Do not pull into hatched lines in front of school gates and keep the school entrance clear
- Do not perform a U-Turn to use the layby or to move away afterwards

Please remember that you can still park at the Sports Park or at the Bulls Head and walk. Also, look out for our Scoot to School initiative being relaunched soon!
