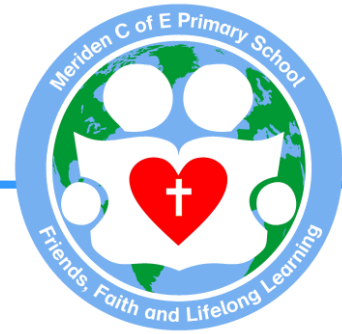

Foundation Stage children only

School sweatshirt or cardigan (with logo)

School white or navy polo shirt (with logo)

Single logo badges are available to sew onto plain polo, sweatshirts or cardigans

Plain grey school trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress

Children in Years 1 - 6

Plain navy v-neck jumper, sweatshirt, cardigan or tank top

White shirt (long or short sleeved)

School tie (elasticated ties may be worn by children in year 1 and 2 only)

(Ties maybe removed during hot weather when authorised)

Plain grey school trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress



All children

Socks or tights must be worn at **all** times. They should be:

grey or white socks / white, grey or navy tights

Black or Navy shoes – **NOT** boots, open toe sandals or high heels

In summer - blue & white checked dress

Any coloured plain hair ornaments of a sensible, small size (no big bows, flowers or head bands).

Outdoors

Sensible warm coat

P E Kit – All children from FS2 - Year 6

Plain house coloured t-shirt **Hawks—Red/ Eagles-Yellow/ Ospreys-Green/ Falcons-Blue**

Plain navy shorts or skort (NOT Lycra/ cycling shorts)

Black plimsolls (indoors) or trainers (outdoors)

Navy or black track suits should be worn during cold weather.

Please note that we do not consider jewellery to be suitable for children in school for safety reasons. If ears are pierced, only simple, plain gold or silver studs are to be worn during the school day, with parental responsibility.

Make up of any sort is not allowed. Nail varnish is not allowed.

All shoulder length hair should be tied back.

Please name all belongings – we can then easily get lost property back to its rightful owner!
