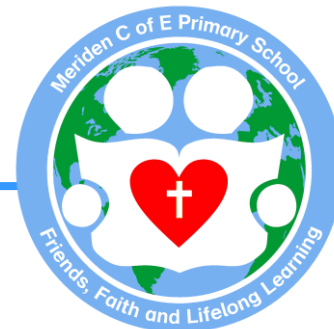

Dear Parents and Carers

A reminder that your child may be entitled to free school meals and or Pupil Premium if they:

- have parents/carers who work in the armed forces
- are in the care of the Local Authority foster care/residential care
- have been adopted from care on or after 29th December 2005 OR who have left care under a special guardianship order OR who have left care under a residence order
- have parents/carers who receive Income Support OR Income based Job Seeker's Allowance
- have parents who receive Employment & Support Allowance ( this must be Income Related and not Contribution Based)
- have parents who receive Child Tax Credit with no Working Tax Credit and where the household income is less than £16,190. NB: You do not qualify if you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit unless you are newly unemployed
- have parents who have an ARC card (Asylum Seekers)
- have parents who receive the guaranteed element of state pension credit.

Pupil Premium could help pay for your child to take part in clubs such as Dazzlers Football, Starstruck, Gymnastics, or be provided with music tuition. School trips contributions can be made on your behalf too. Pupil Premium also helps to support children in class, with teaching assistant hours, specific resources etc.

**Even if your child is in FS2, Year 1 or Year 2 and already receive the Universal Free Meals (UFMS) you still need to apply to register for FSM/ Pupil Premium.**
