Red Ridge 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> October 2017

With our trip fast approaching, I would like to invite you to a short meeting on **Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> September at 3:30pm** to explain details of the residential and answer any questions you may have. ### **Please remember your sleeping bag!**

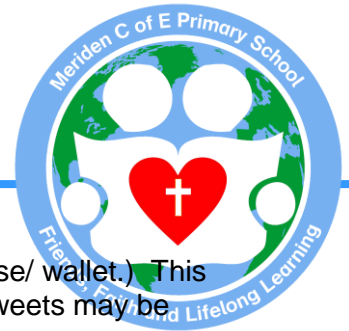

The children may bring up to £10 (coins only please in a named purse/ wallet.) This will be kept safe until the evening of the disco, when souvenirs and sweets may be bought.

Red Ridge have requested that food, sweets or drinks should **not** be sent in children's luggage. If you have any concerns regarding your children's dietary requirements, please contact us as soon as possible.

Disposable cameras are welcome but they will be the responsibility of the children at all times. Please ensure that these are clearly labelled to avoid confusion over ownership.

Children may bring a small game to share, e.g. cards/ travel games, but **NO** electronic games, ipods, tablets or mobile phones – these will be confiscated if found.

You will need to provide a packed lunch for Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October. This should be placed in a disposable container and should not contain fizzy drinks, cans or bottles.

With regards to the Code of Conduct Form, if it is deemed necessary to send your child home due to disruptive behaviour, you will not be reimbursed for the days your child is not at Red Ridge.
