Y3 and Y4 trip to Safeside

Dear Parents and Carers,

During our forthcoming 'safety week' the children will have a range of opportunities to develop their knowledge, skills and understanding around areas such as water safety, e-safety and first aid. The Year 3 and 4 pupils however, have the opportunity to visit Safeside as part of the week of learning to further their understanding of the risks around fire. This will take place on **Tuesday 27th February**.

In years past, Year 6 have used this facility and have had a wonderful time developing their life-long learning skills.

The children will be there for the full day where half of the day will be instructor led and the other half teacher led. We see this as a valuable opportunity for children to have an enriching experience in developing their understanding of the hazards around fire.

The trip has been subsidised by school fund however there is a small charge of **£4** per child to help cover the cost of travel and the day at Safeside.

This is a voluntary contribution but we do need to point out that the visit will not be viable unless the parents who are able to are willing to contribute. In the event of insufficient contributions (i.e. less than 80%) the trip will be cancelled; please speak to Mrs Anderton if you have any difficulties making payment. Please make your payment via the '**Safeside 2018**' basket on ParentPay. If your child receives free school meals the contribution may be covered by the Pupil Premium grant – however your consent is still required.

All children will need a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please) and lunch (preferably in a throw away container or carrier). The school cook is happy to provide a packed lunch and drink for your child at a cost of £2.05. Please ensure there is enough credit on your child's school meal account.
