Curriculum – Children benefit from having ownership of a relevant, diverse and innovative curriculum which meets the needs of individuals and groups of pupils

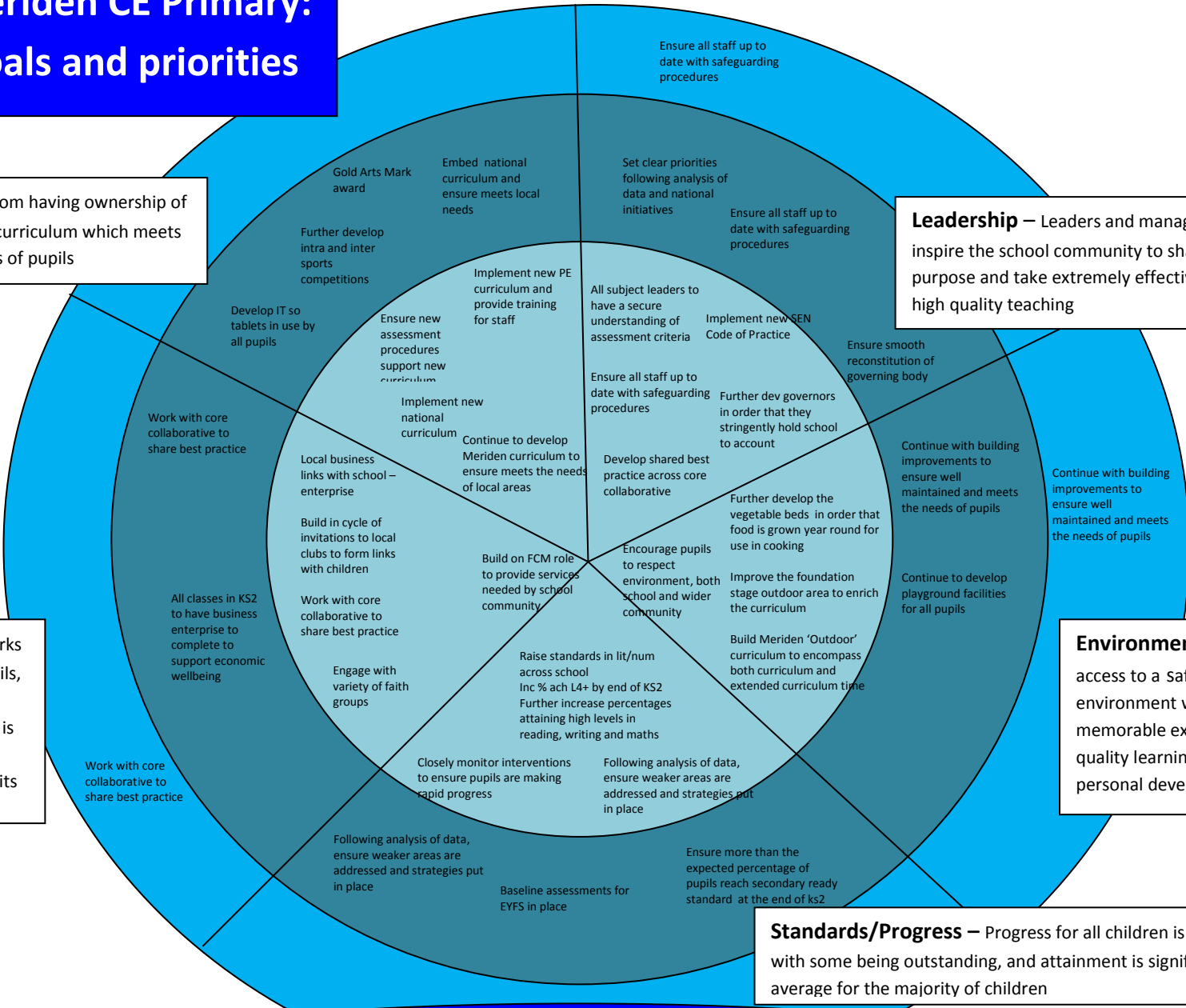
Leadership – Leaders and managers at all levels inspire the school community to share a strong sense of purpose and take extremely effective steps to sustain high quality teaching
