We will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts based around our topic of Rivers. To start with we will be exploring descriptive writing. We will be looking at high-quality texts and illustrations and writing our own exciting descriptions. We will then be looking at adventure stories and narrative. We will be writing the journey of a raindrop as it travels through the water cycle.

Our topic for the Spring Term is....

Rivers

This is an exciting geography topic through which we will locate and explore the most famous rivers in the world. We will discover the features of a river and their journey from source to mouth. We will also look at the water cycle and discover how floods occur.
